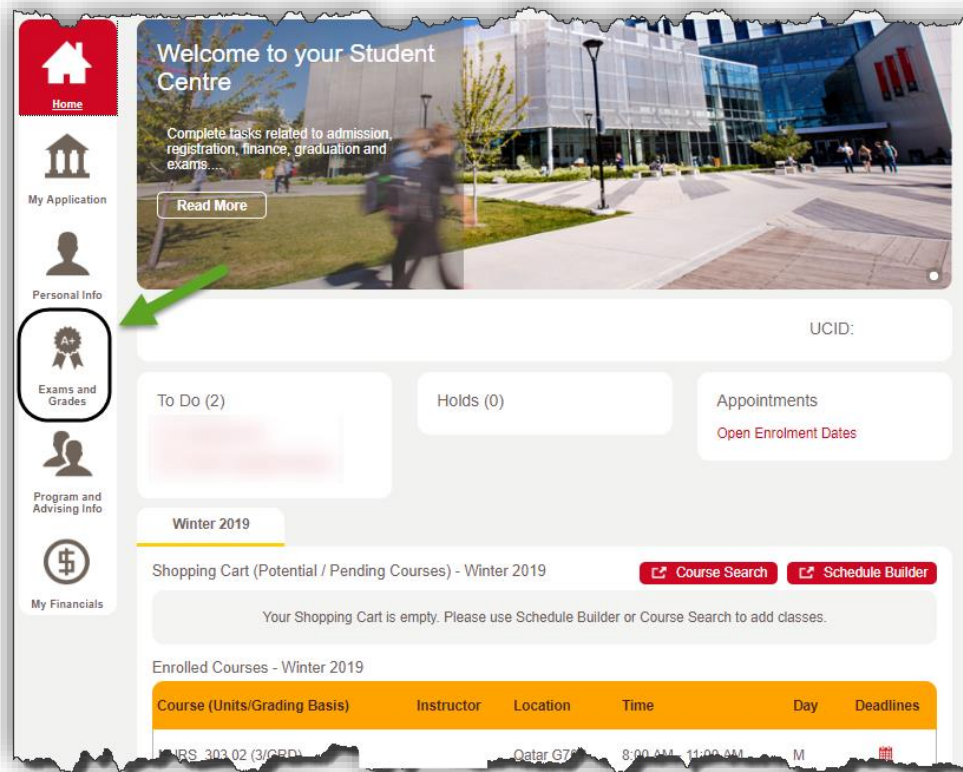

Course Numbering System: Junior courses - courses numbered from 100-299. Senior courses - courses numbered from 300-599. Courses numbered 600 and above are normally restricted to students completing graduate programs. Important Information for Sponsored Part-Time Post-Diploma Bachelor of Nursing (PDBN) students.

- Students are allowed to take 2 courses in the Fall and Winters and 1 course in the Spring semester. Exceptions must be approved in writing by both your sponsor and the Associate Dean (Academic).
